GETTING TO THE SUMMIT CONFERENCE VENUE

At Akademie Franz-Hitze-Haus, Kardinal-von-Galen-Ring 50, 48149 Münster (<https://www.franz-hitze-haus.de/tagungshaus>)

AIRPLANE

Münster/Osnabrück International Airport (FMO) offers a select number of connections and located on the outskirts of the city, is about 30-40 minutes away by bus (€7.50) or taxi (€40-50). Regular shuttle services from and to train station Münster are available via bus line S50 (fast line) and R51 of Regionalverkehr Münsterland GmbH (RVM). Help with details regarding bus tickets is available at the [airport service point](#).

Düsseldorf International Airport (DUS) offers many connections to cities across Europe. It takes about 90 minutes by train to reach Münster. Train fares are around €30. Every 60 minutes regional train "RE 2" offers a direct service from the airport train station to Münster Central Station. You can search for connections and buy tickets in advance on the German Railway website <https://int.bahn.de/en/> Search for Connections from DUSSELDORF AEROPORT to "Münster(Westf) Hbf".



Frankfurt International Airport (FRA) is also an option if you cannot find suitable connection to DUS or FMO. From "Frankfurt am Main Flughafen Fernbahnhof", the long-distance train station, to "Münster(Westf) Hbf" there are hourly direct fast-train (ICE) connections that cost about 70 Euro. Travel time is about 3 hours, connections and tickets can be found here <https://int.bahn.de/en/>

GETTING TO AKADEMIE FRANZ-HITZE-HAUS FROM MÜNSTER CENTRAL STATION

From Münster Central station (Hauptbahnhof), you can reach the conference venue (Akademie Franz-Hitze-Haus) by bus, or taxi cab. Take Bus #2 which departs in front of the Central Station on platform C1, headed toward "Alte Sternwarte" and disembark at stop "Franz-Hitze-Haus" (3,20 Euros; about 25 minute travel time). A taxi cab from the Central Station to the conference venue costs about 15 Euro.
